

Rules and Conditions of Entry

All ridden horses and ponies must be four (4) years and over.

No Refund of entry fees can be made once entry is accepted after the closing date

No entries accepted without full payment.

Postal entries will be given priority. Entries on the day may be limited.

The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and also to amend the schedule.

Hard hats, to a recognised standard, must be worn at all times with chin strap secured when mounted. Correct riding wear must also be worn. Body protectors to be worn for cross country classes.

Cantering outside of the rings is not permitted except in the designated warm up area.

All Dogs to be kept on lead at all times.

All competitors (including Clear Round and Dressage) must wear a number which will be given on payment of a £3.00 donation towards medical cover.

Age as on date of show.

If due to unforeseen circumstances the selected Judge is unable to fulfil their commitment, the Committee reserve the right to appoint an alternative Judge at short notice (after printing of the schedule), without informing Competitors prior to the start of the show.

In all instances, the Judges decision is final.

Neither the Avon Vale Hunt Organising Committee, nor the landowners accept any liability for any accident, theft, injury to horse, pony, rider, spectator or any person whatsoever, or their property.
